Australia's Keys to Competitiveness

Primary Aluminium

- · Australia is the 7th largest global producer.
- Electricity accounts for 30-40% of smelters cost base and is a key driver of competitiveness.


Alumina

- Australia is the 2nd largest global producer.
- Energy accounts for 30-40% of refineries cost base and is a key driver of competitiveness.
- Proximity to bauxite is a key driver, although bauxite is now increasingly mobile and access to green energy is of increasing comparative importance.


Bauxite

- Australia is the largest global producer.
- Australia is the 2nd largest exporter.
- Australian bauxite mining is regarded as having some of the highest sustainability standards in the world, particularly for rehabilitation.
- Guinea is the world's largest exporter, principally to China, including some captive bauxite mines.


Global Aluminium Production Rankings




Primary Aluminium Trade Flows




Global Alumina Production Rankings
